MYSTERY OBJECT - THE CLUES

[This text is read aloud at the beginning of this video:]

Welcome to Stories for Lipreading. If you haven't used our website before, we suggest you look at our 'How to Use' page before you begin. We hope you enjoy solving these clues to help you guess a mystery object.

I'm going to say 7 short sentences. Each sentence is a clue to help you identify the mystery object. The clues describe the object. The first 6 clues all start with the words: 'This object...'

The clues are all on a document called 'The Clues', but the answer is on a separate document called 'The Answer'.

To help you get started, I will tell you that it is a common household object.

Mystery Object – The Clues

1. This object is made of wire.
2. This object is made of wire but it could be made of wood or plastic.
3. This object is shaped a bit like a triangle.
4. This object has a hook at the top in the middle.
5. This object is about 16 inches or 41 cm wide.
6. This object was in my wardrobe.
7. You will have some of these objects in your wardrobe.
